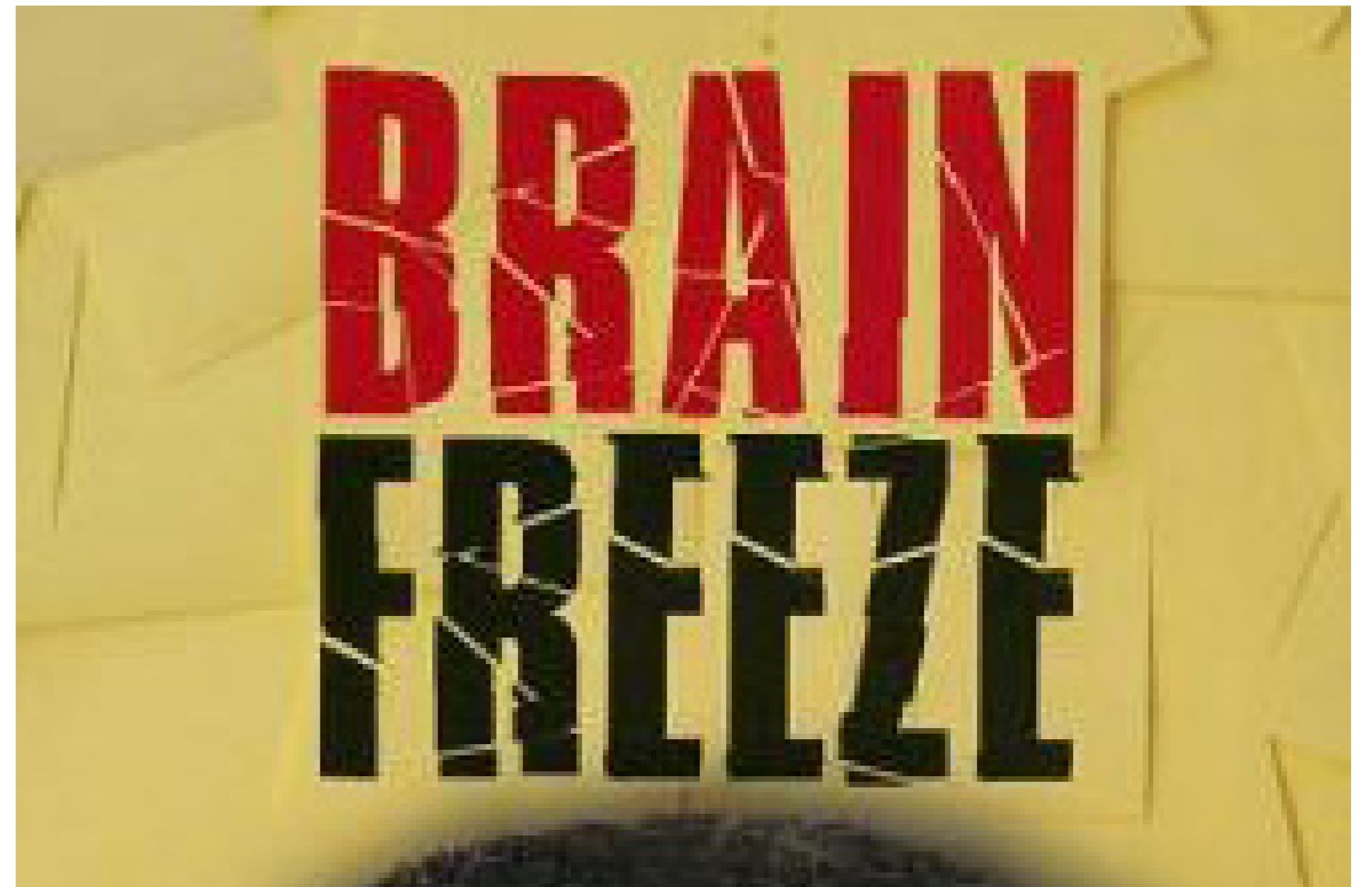
ADULTS GO FREE WITH CHILD
