How to make a booking for a blood test at Tallaght Hospital

Tallaght Hospital has introduced a new service for Patients and GP's to view and book blood test appointments online at <http://www.amnch.ie/>. This is a **FREE** service and no charges will apply for making an online booking. We hope as a result that you will experience a more efficient service & we strongly encourage availing of this easy-to-use facility.

This step-by-step guide will help with making your appointment. Remember, when you attend for the test -

- You must have a Tallaght Hospital GP request form signed by your GP to avail of this service.
- Confirm with your GP in advance if you are required to fast for your blood test.
- Check with your GP in advance if you should take your medication before your blood test.
